St. Mary's Health Care System (Family Birth Center)

- Breastfeeding classes before baby's delivery
- Breastfeeding help at the hospital bedside after baby's delivery
- Breastfeeding support groups on Mondays and Fridays after discharge
- Breastfeeding out-patient visits scheduled as needed

- 1st night: An introduction to breastfeeding (how to get started and be successful)
- 2nd night: Discussion of breastfeeding options for women returning to work or school, pumping options, milk storage, as well as different types of pumps and their uses

Public Health

A major goal of the WIC Program is to improve the nutritional status of infants; therefore, WIC promotes and supports breastfeeding as the optimal infant feeding choice, unless medically contraindicated. WIC mothers choosing to breastfeed are provided information through counseling and breastfeeding materials. Peer Counselors are also available to provide follow up breastfeeding support. Mothers who exclusively breastfeed their infants receive an enhanced food package and mothers can be loaned breast pumps to help support the initiation and continuation of breastfeeding.
